Scope of work:

Redpath Black Diamond will be the primary contractor on an underground mine development project located in Matheson, Ontario. The planned development will consist of waste and ore development in the Smoke Zone and Middle Zone consisting of approximately 1590 meters of development of different sizes.



Job Summary:

Under the supervision of the Shift Supervisor, the primary role of the Truck Driver is to haul and dump broken ore and waste from development or production headings.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Refuel, check coolant and engine and hydraulic oils, lubricate all points and complete standard daily check forms and drives equipment to and from work area
- Visually inspects, sounds, scales and washes down work area, if required
- Operates manual and remote scoop tram to load bucket with ore/waste; hauls to dump or loads onto truck, and transports mine supplies
- Advances vent tubing, installs or removes air and water pipes to facilitate own work
- Operate traffic control signals where applicable and respond to signals to prevent a vehicle accident
- Completes daily log book on equipment and submits written and verbal reports
- Report progress and any unusual occurrences to supervisor
- Maintains working area and equipment in a clean and orderly condition
- Must be able to comprehend written and verbal instructions as required to perform his duties in a safe and efficient manner
- The duties and responsibilities listed above are representative of the nature and level of work assigned and are not necessarily all inclusive

Required Skills and Qualifications:

- **Ontario Hard Rock Underground Common Core – Full Basic (or other provincial equivalent) (required)**

- High school diploma or equivalent (preferred)
- Basic literacy (read, write, basic math) required
- Minimum 2-3 years' experience running heavy equipment machinery
- Experience operating 30 ton underground trucks
- Ability to multi task and work effectively
- Ability to work efficiently as part of a team as well as independently
- Knowledge of truck and equipment safety
- Knowledge of operation of front end loaders, dozers, graders, compactors, snow blowers and other pieces of heavy equipment
